The submission deadline is 5 p.m. Tuesday, January 22, 2019, to Nominating Committee Chair Mary L. Johnson.


Other Nominating Committee members

Applicants must answer these four questions:

1. Include specific examples of situations in which you faced challenges and how you handling of those situations have helped direct you to the path that you are on.
2. In 50 words or less, describe how you have had a positive impact on the community.
3. Rising college costs have reached critical levels in recent years, leaving graduates with massive debt and difficulty finding jobs in their field of study that pay enough to survive in today's economy. Discuss how your college plans will help ensure that you are successful upon completing your degree.
4. Aside from the issues of college debt and employability, what is the single greatest challenge facing Generation Z individuals?
