

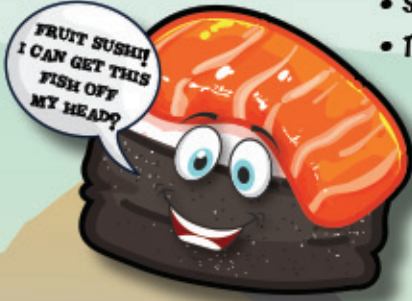


THE LIFE OF MONEY

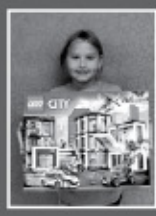
